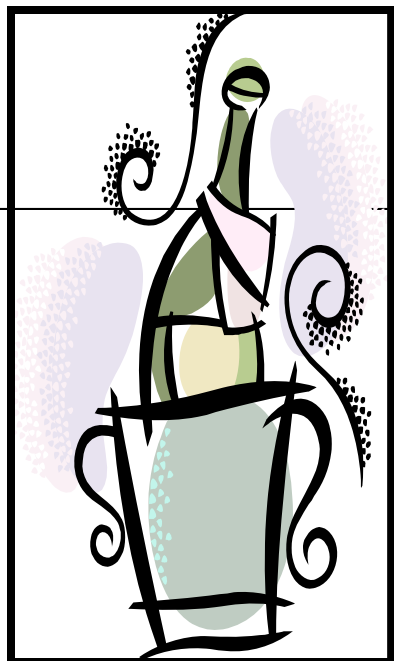



The Governor and Officers




I would like to take this opportunity to address many questions concerning the status of the Park Avenue Club (formerly the Charity Club). For those members who have not been a part of the Park Avenue Club in the past, let me explain what it is. The club is available for any Moose member and their spouse. The cost to join is \$60 and includes a fall buffet dinner with DJ, a spring buffet dinner with a DJ, and the Clam Bake in August behind the Sellersville Firehouse from 1-6 pm. At the Clam Bake, each member receives a 15-pc clam bake, a piece of fish, half of a BBQ chicken, a plate of 5 raw clams, unlimited steamed corn on the cob all day, unlimited hamburgers and hot dogs all day, Chef Jack's homemade clam chowder all day, ring bologna and 2 kinds of cheese all day, and FREE BEER all day. In addition to the outings, we had a drawing all year based on the 7:00 lottery where, if your Park Ave. Club number hit, you would get \$10 and, at the end of the year Clam Bake, we gave away \$500 to a few lucky members. The purpose of this club, which has seemed to have gotten lost over the years, is for any funds left over to go to the building fund. We would like to keep the Park Avenue club going with a few minor changes. The Kickoff Dinner will be in March, the Clam Bake will still be the same week in August that it has been for the past 29 years, and the Fall Dance will be in October or November (yet to be decided). There will be a sign-up sheet at the Moose for each of the dances and the Clam Bake and, for each of these events, there will be a 2 ½ WEEK CUTOFF so we can order the correct amount of food for the event. This is very important so that the Park Ave. Club does not lose money with having a ton of food left over. There will then be a table at each event where you will receive your ticket to that event. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR PARK AVE. MEMBERSHIP CARD WITH YOU** to get your ticket. As always, you may bring friends along for \$15 each for the dinner dances or \$35 for the Clam Bake. To join the Park Ave. Club, **YOU MUST SIGN UP** and be paid in full by Sunday, January 30th. The club **MUST** have a **MINIMUM** of 200 people for the club to continue. If we do not get the minimum of 200 people, the lodge will mail your check back to you. Please come out and sign up. If you want the same club number you had last year, please bring your membership card with you when you sign up. The more members we have, the more money we can give away at the end of the year and we can always use a larger donation to the building fund.
