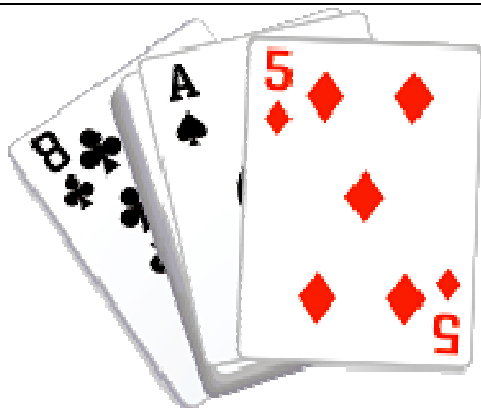
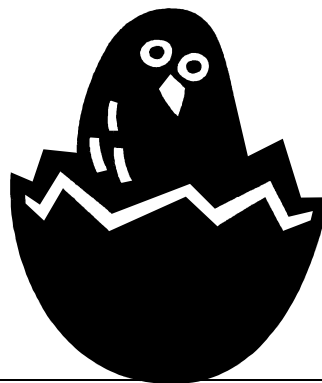

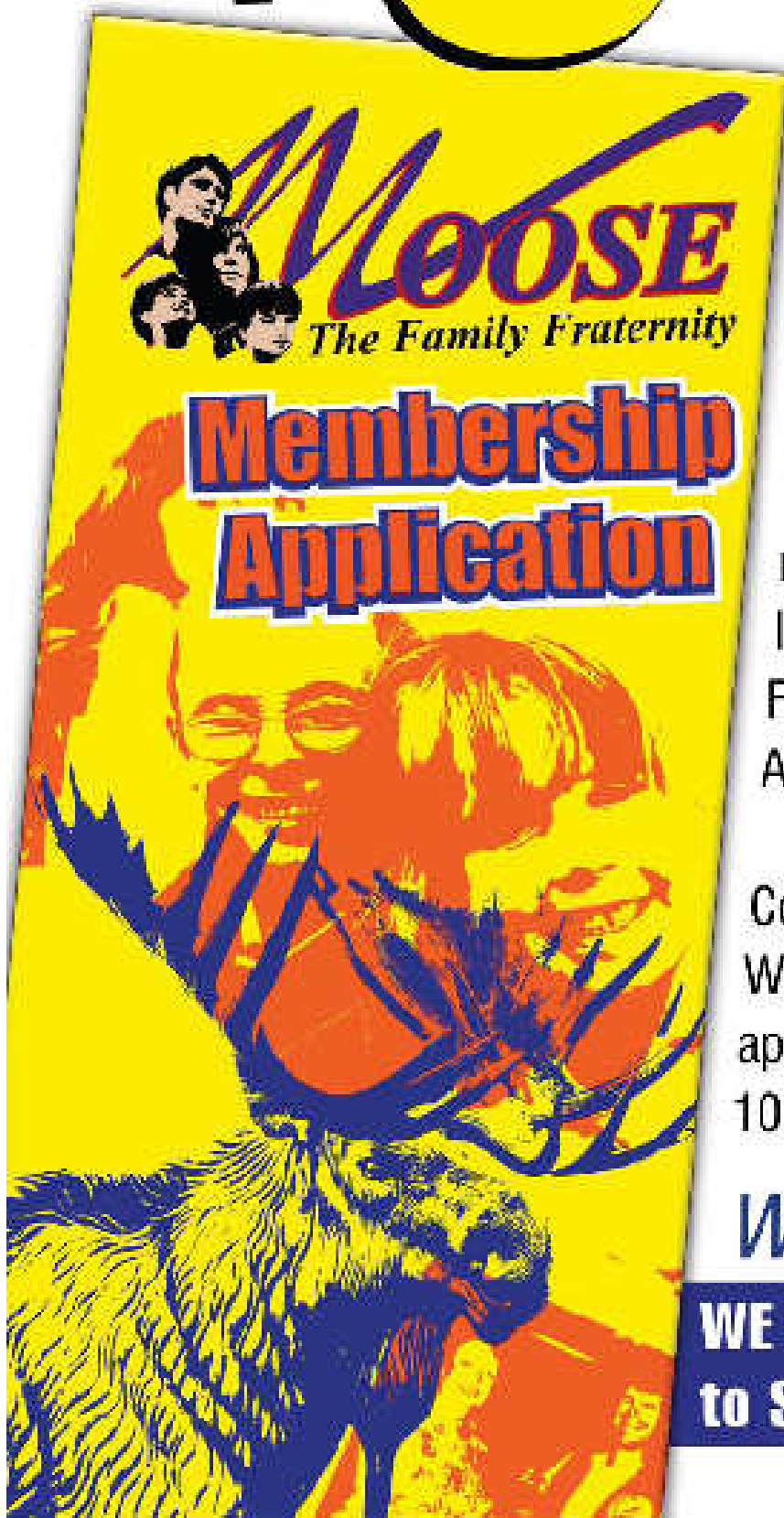

## BINGO



Every Wednesday, we play Bingo with the lighted bingo board. You can sit at the bar or in the dining room. The cost is \$16 for a book of 16 cards with 3 regular games on each card. For \$1 more, you can get your book stamped and be eligible to win the bonus. When the bonus number comes up, if you have Bingo on the next ball picked, you win the bonus money. At the time of printing, the bonus is over \$100 and climbing every week until somebody wins. Then, it starts at a few dollars the next week and builds back up again. We play 12 regular Bingo game and 4 special games. For regular Bingo, you can win \$15-\$30, based on the total number of bingo books we sell that night. 3 special games are for \$30 and one of them is for \$50. The last game is always one of the \$30 specials and it is also what we call the “Cover All”. If you cover all of the numbers on your card within that week’s number of balls, you win **\$500 DOLLARS**. At the time of printing, the number is at 57 so, if you cover your card in 57 number or less, you win the \$500. If no one has Bingo after that many numbers are called, the first player to cover their card wins **\$100 DOLLARS**. That last games is worth \$100 to the winner EVERY WEEK. The Cover All number will go up to 58 the next week and it will continue to go up until somebody wins the \$500. When that happens, the Cover All number starts over at 50 and the cycle starts all over again.

**Chef Jack** cooks in the kitchen on Wednesday’s. The bar menu is available along with a few specials and the soup of the day. There is fun to be had for all ages. Over time, there seems to have developed a small rivalry between the younger, more rowdy members at the bar and the slightly older members in the dining area. This is a lot of fund so come out and enjoy.

On Sunday, January 30, 2011, the Moose Legion held its first breakfast of the year. We had Chef Jack and Governor Steve Wampole making eggs and omelets to order. The Moose Legion holds events like this to raise money to help Lodge 1539.
