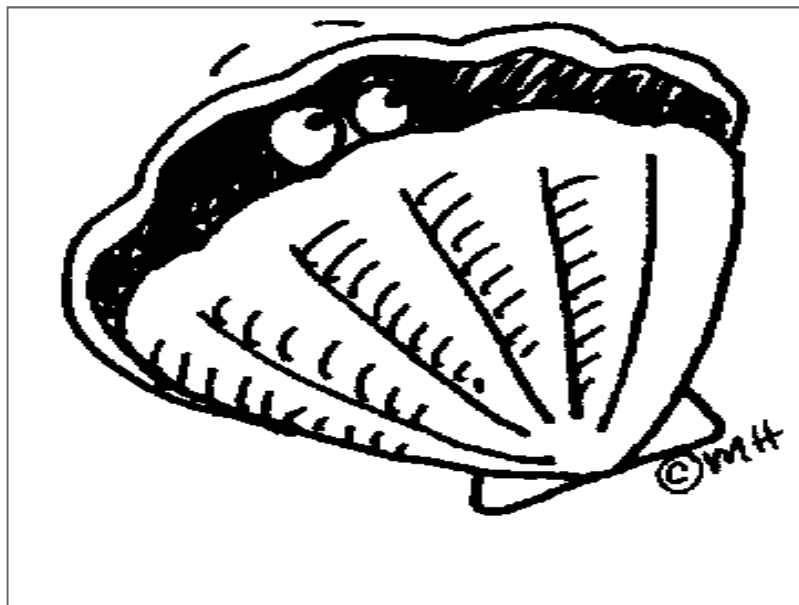

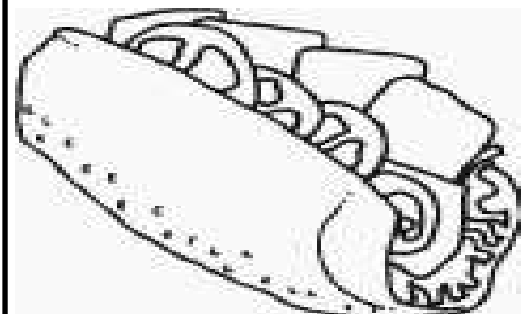
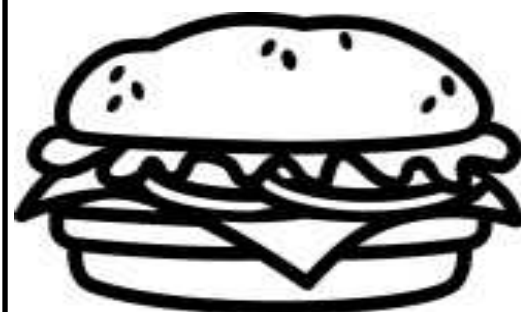
In the past week, I have been approached by members of other lodges about our Moose Legion (for those of you who remind us all the time, I am talking about the MOOSE LEGION.)

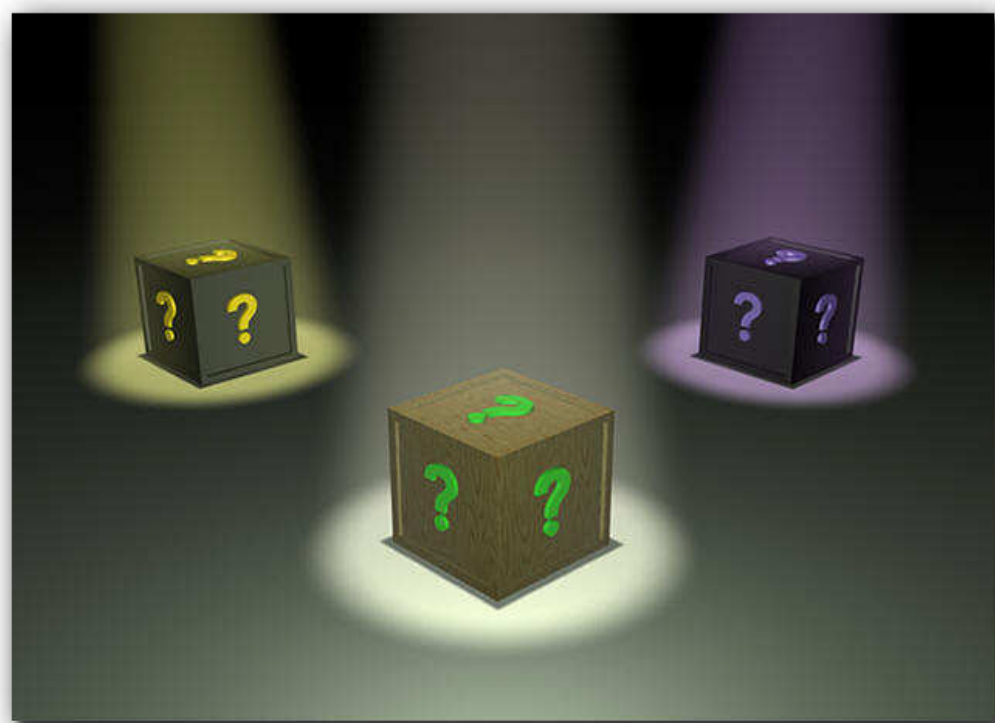
