What can this Committee do to encourage you to physically participate in its Fundraising activities?

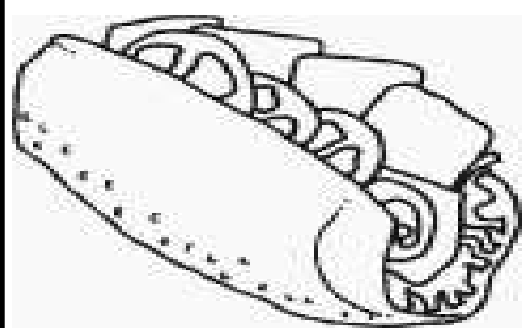
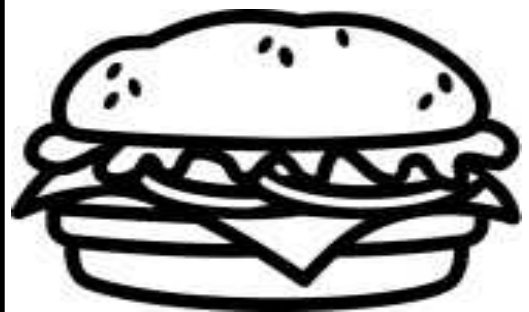

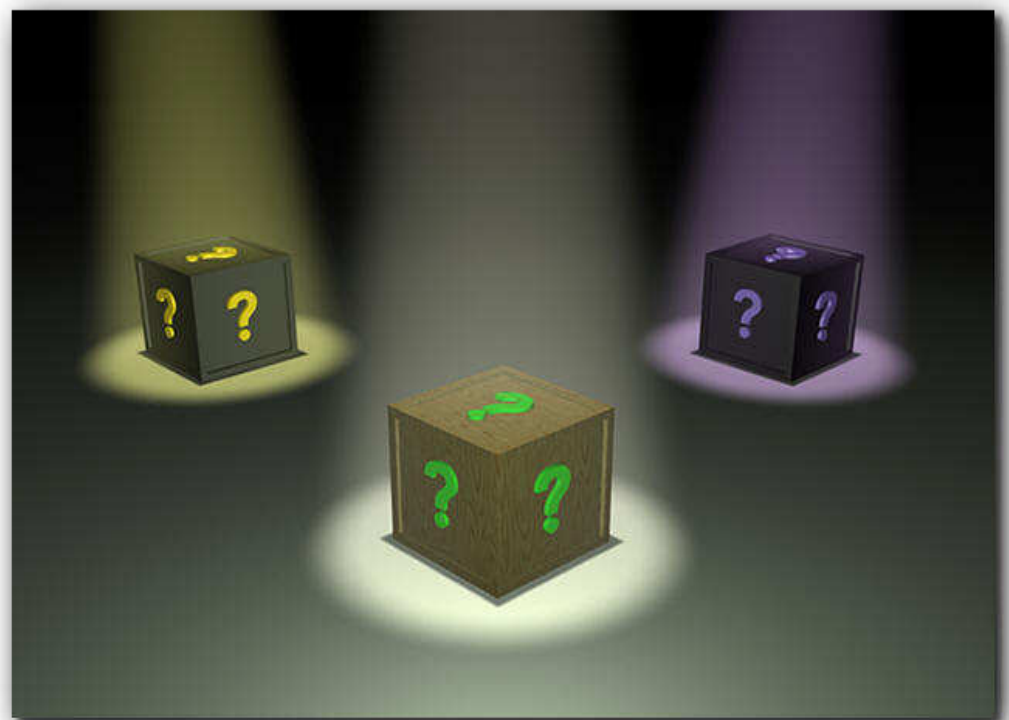
