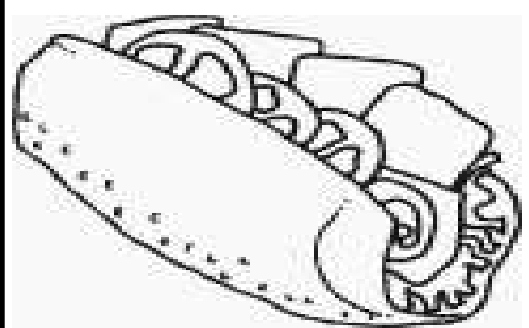
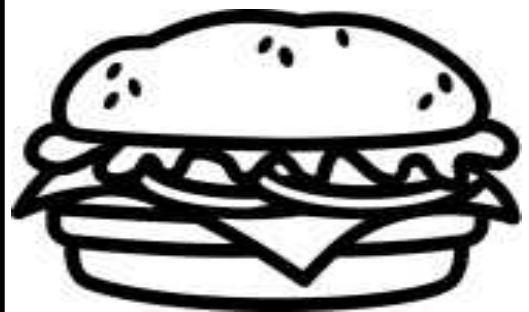


Moose Legion Committee

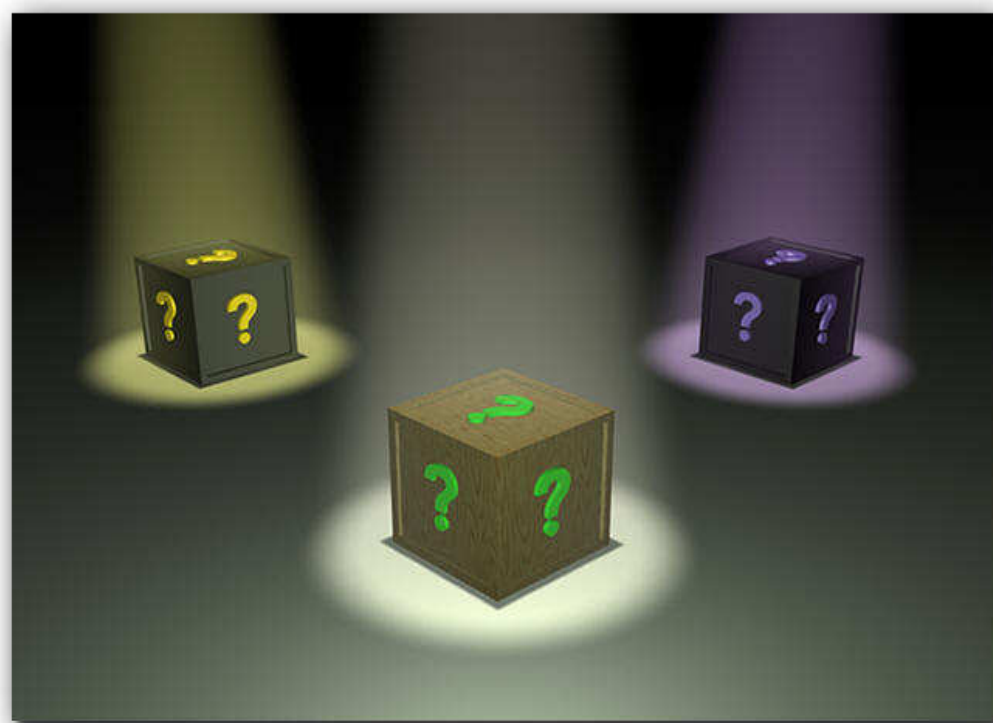
