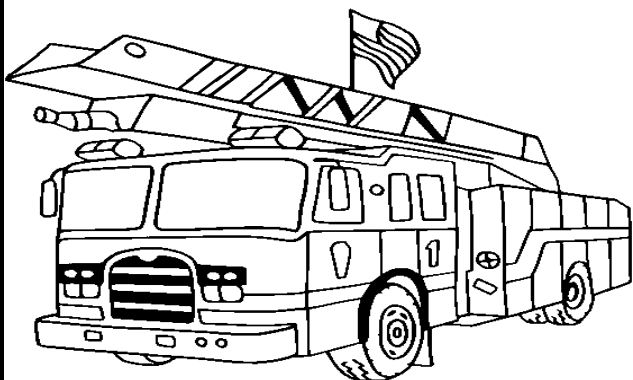

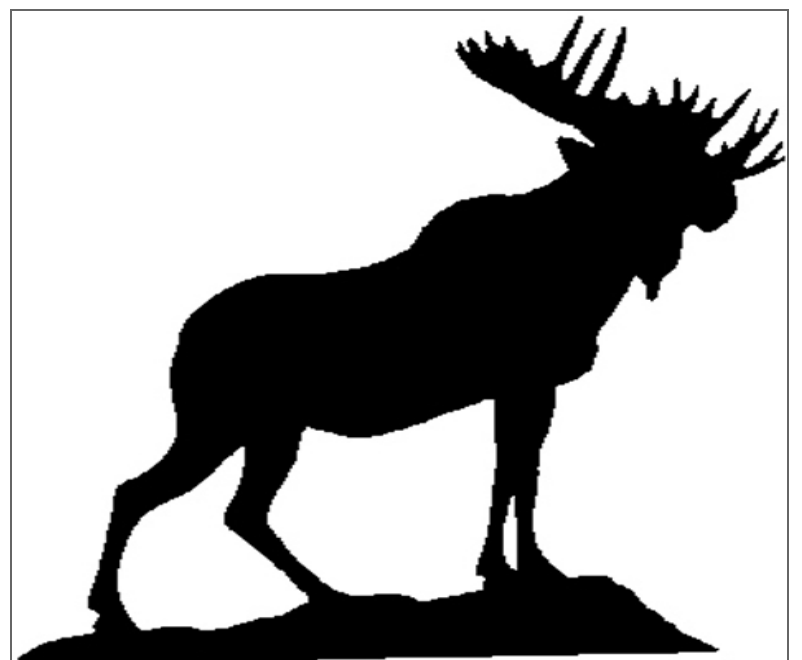

Doers of Good Deeds

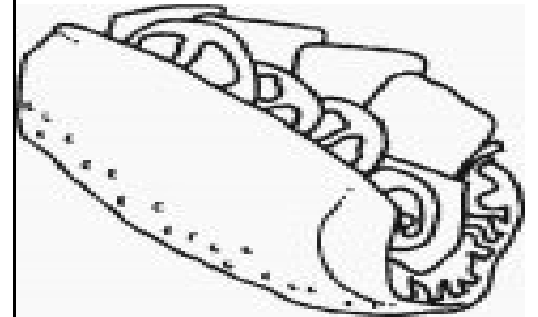
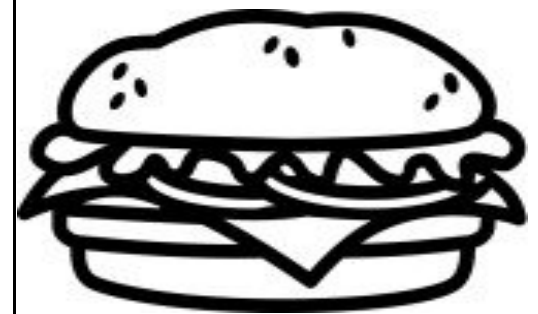
