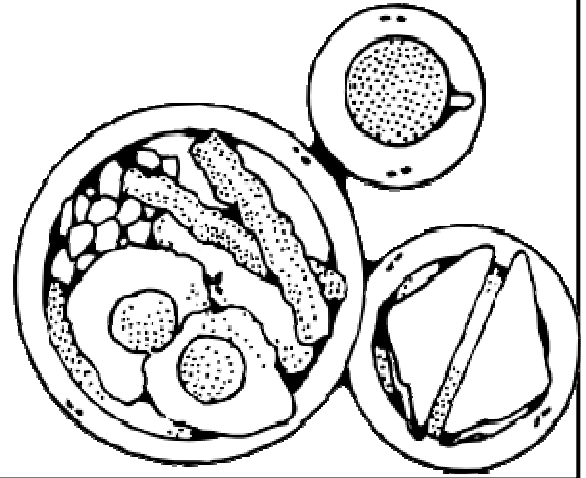

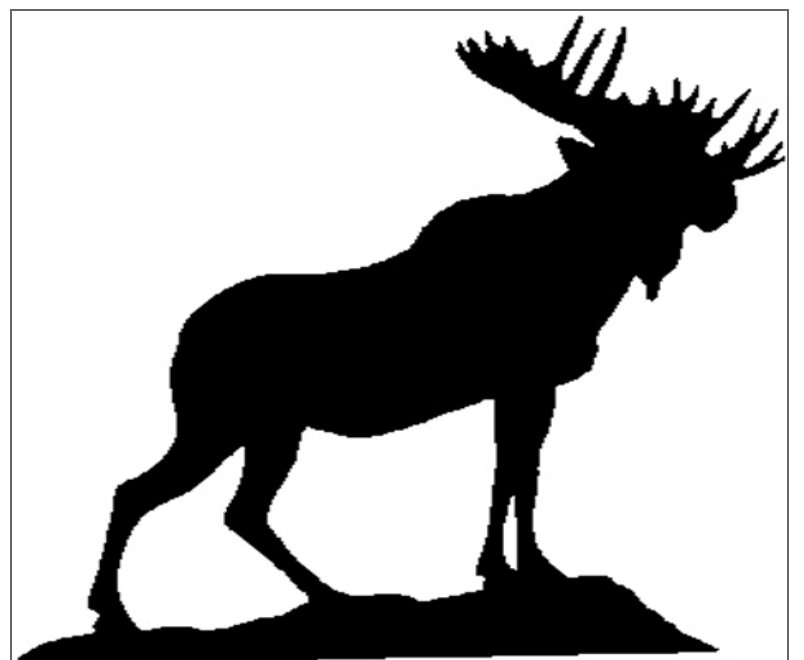

WHO BELONGS TO THE MOOSE LEGION?

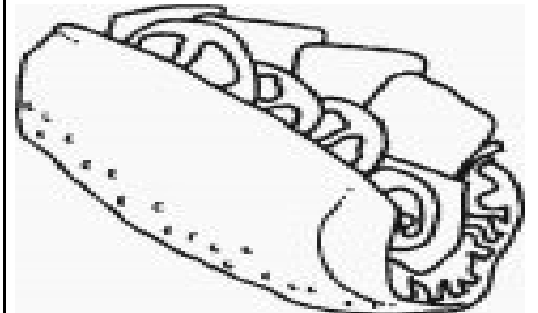
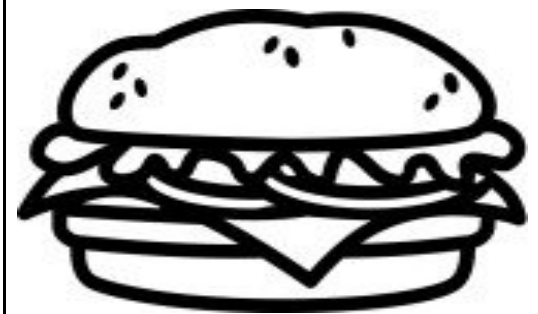
