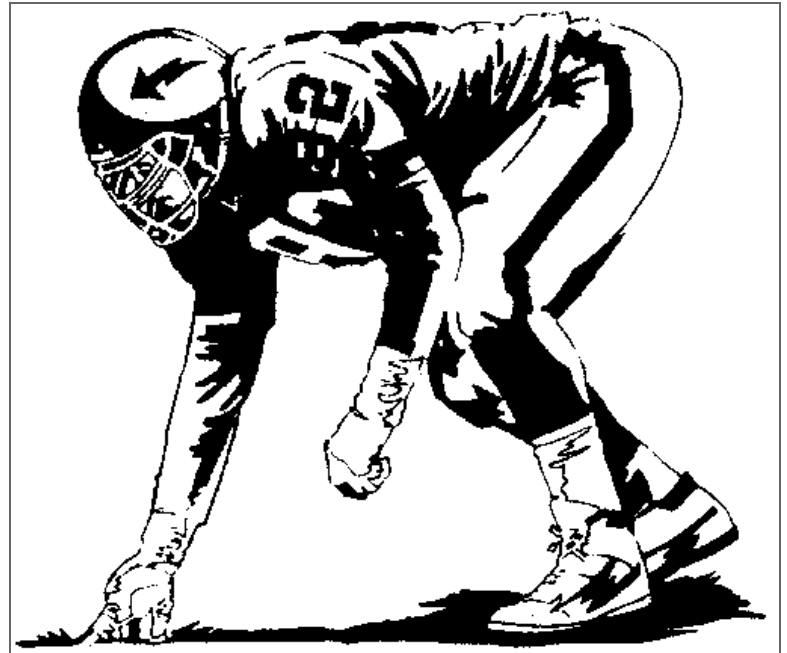

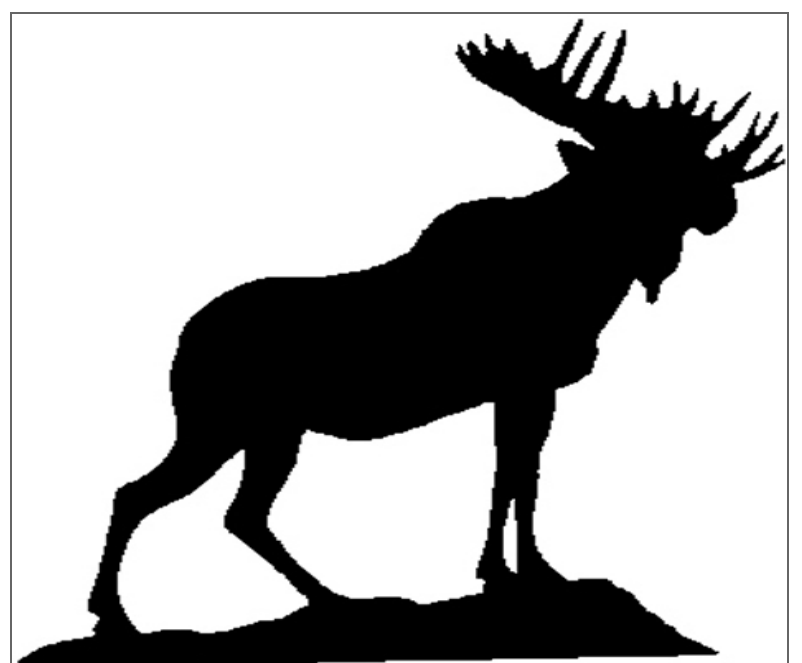

Joining the Moose Legion is easy. All it takes is the desire to help make Sellersville 1539 the best it can be. Watch for upcoming events for Moose Legion members.

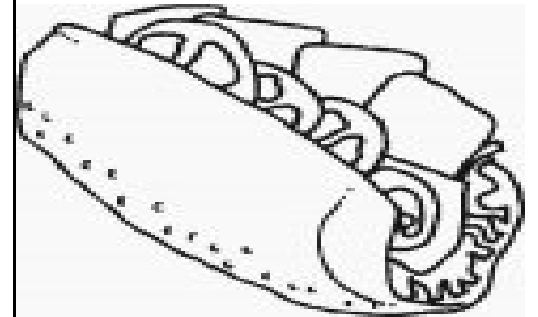
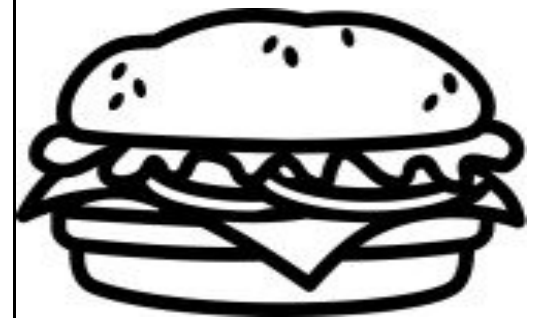
