I hope everyone had a safe and happy holiday season. Thanks to all who participated in the food drive for our local food bank. Our community service efforts do not go unnoticed.

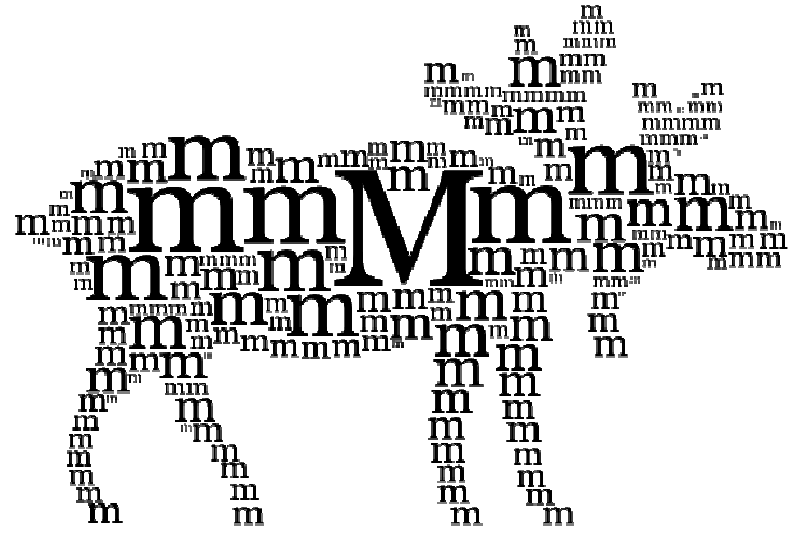
